* If Petit \& Fritsen ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ handbells, other auxiliary bells, or tubular chimes are available, play only the top note. If other handbells or handchimes are used, play both notes. Auxiliary handbells may be played on a handbell tree if desired.

An edition for 2 octaves is available, code CGB1295. The two editions are compatible for massed ringing.

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* Each suspended malleted bell should be held separately as illustrated on page 2 . All bells in the chord should ascend together on beats 1 and 2 and descend on beats 3 and 4 .
** C6 and D6 chimes should be played by Position 1. E6 and F6 chimes should be played by Position 2.




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
