

### Third Sunday of Easter: April 30, 2006

1. Psalm 4: Children sing this antiphon/refrain before verse one, after verse four, and after verse eight.

#### Antiphon: Psalm 4:1a

2. Epistle Lesson: I John 3:1-7

Lector finishes the reading.
