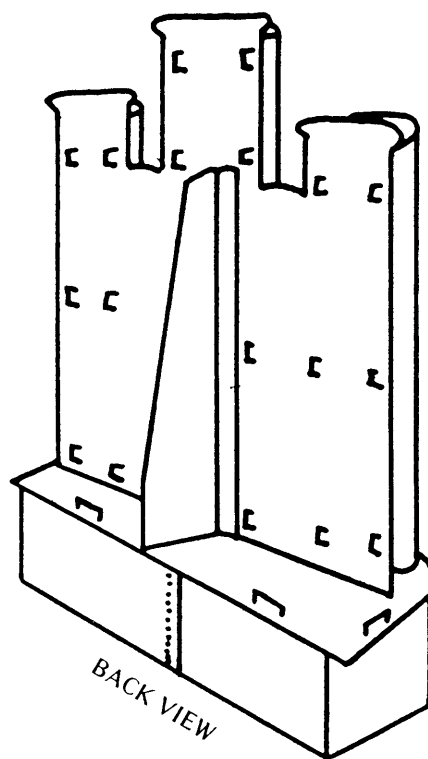
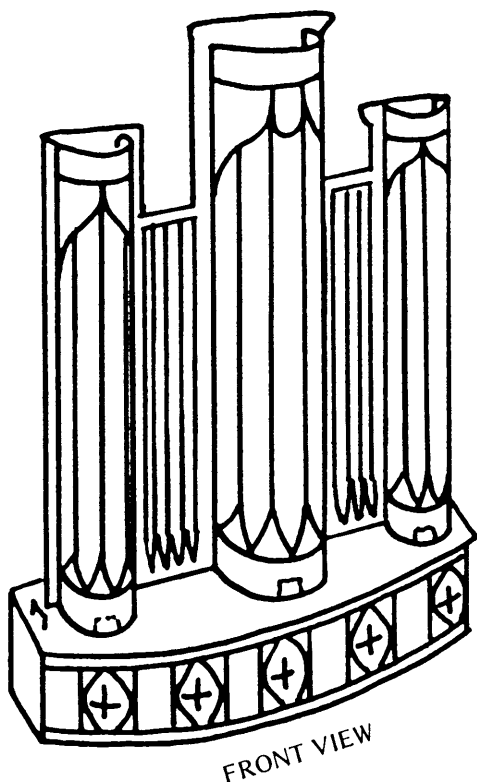


PIPE ORGAN: CONSOLE, PIPES, and CASEWORK

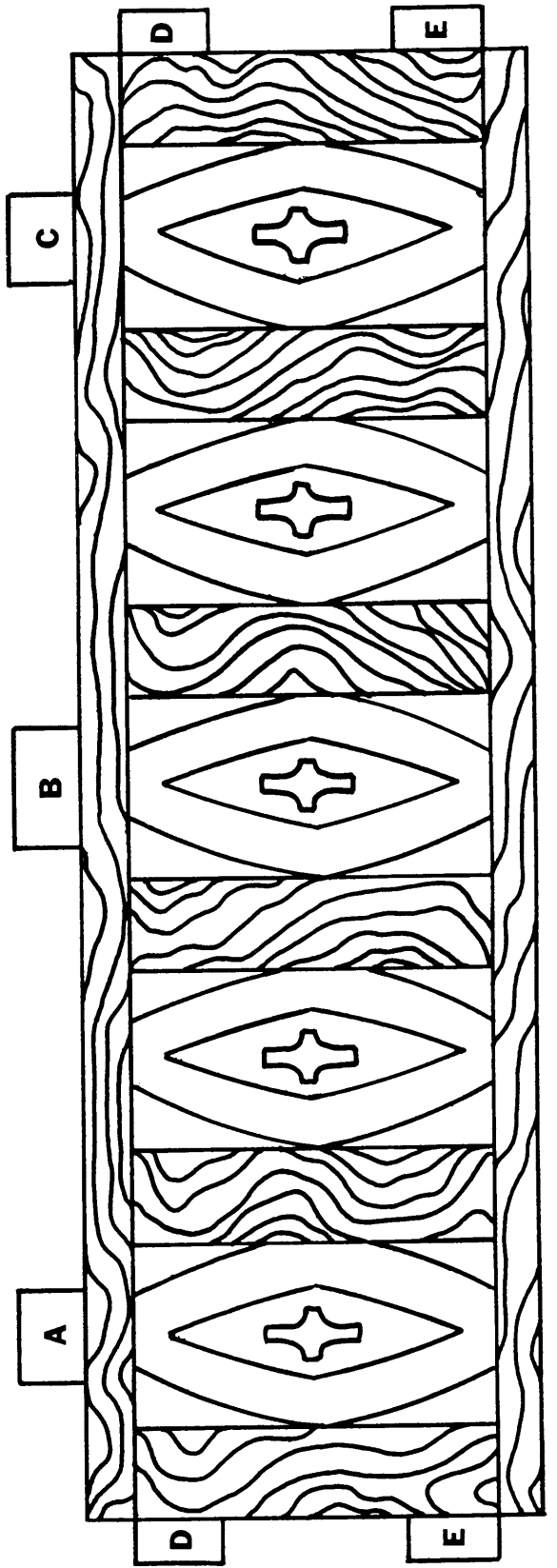

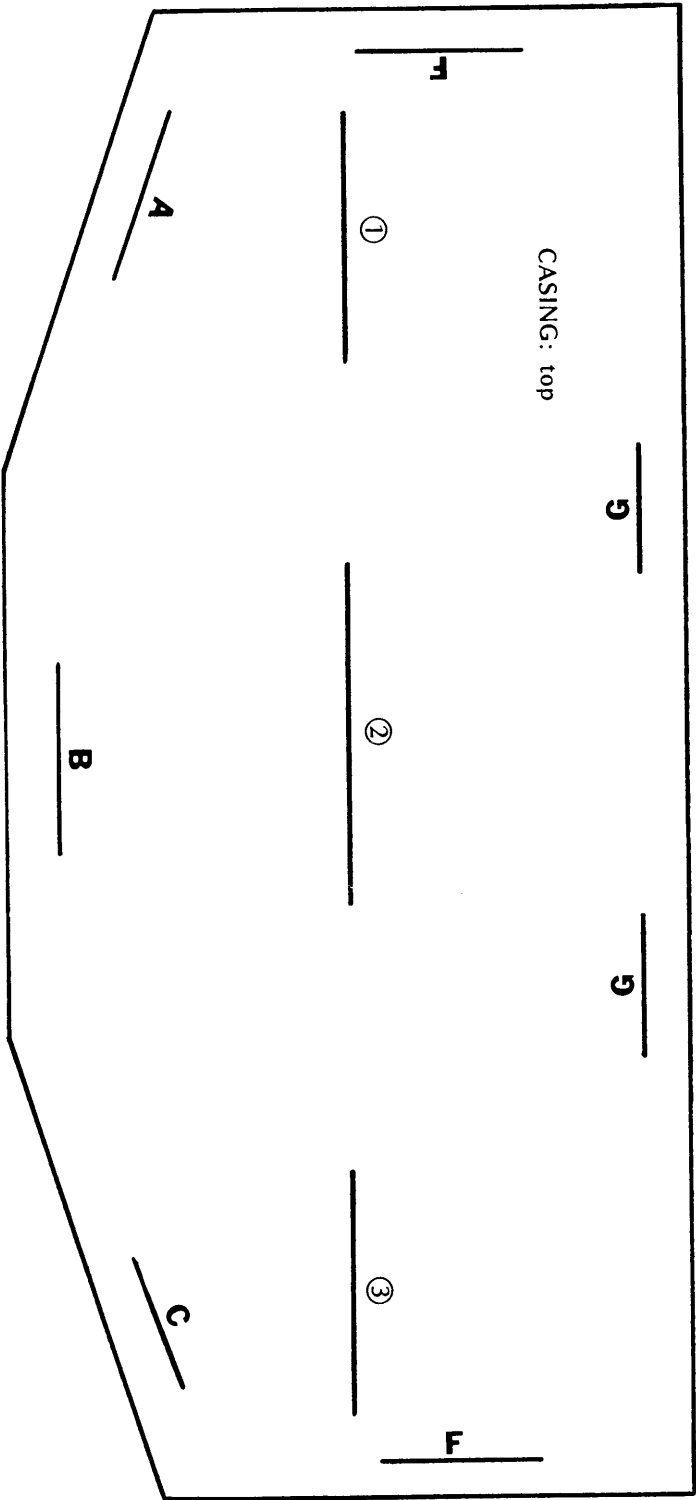
1. Color pipes "silver" (gray), brasswork yellow and wood brown. Back support does not need coloring.
2. Cut each piece out. With X-acto knife, cut slots.
3. Assemble. Tab A goes in Slot A, Tab B in Slot B, etc.
4. Center back casing overlaps slightly.
Affix with tape or staples.
5. Front casing tabs should slip out of sight beneath pipes.
6. Back support may be attached with tape or glue.
7. The console fits on the floor in front of center pipes.

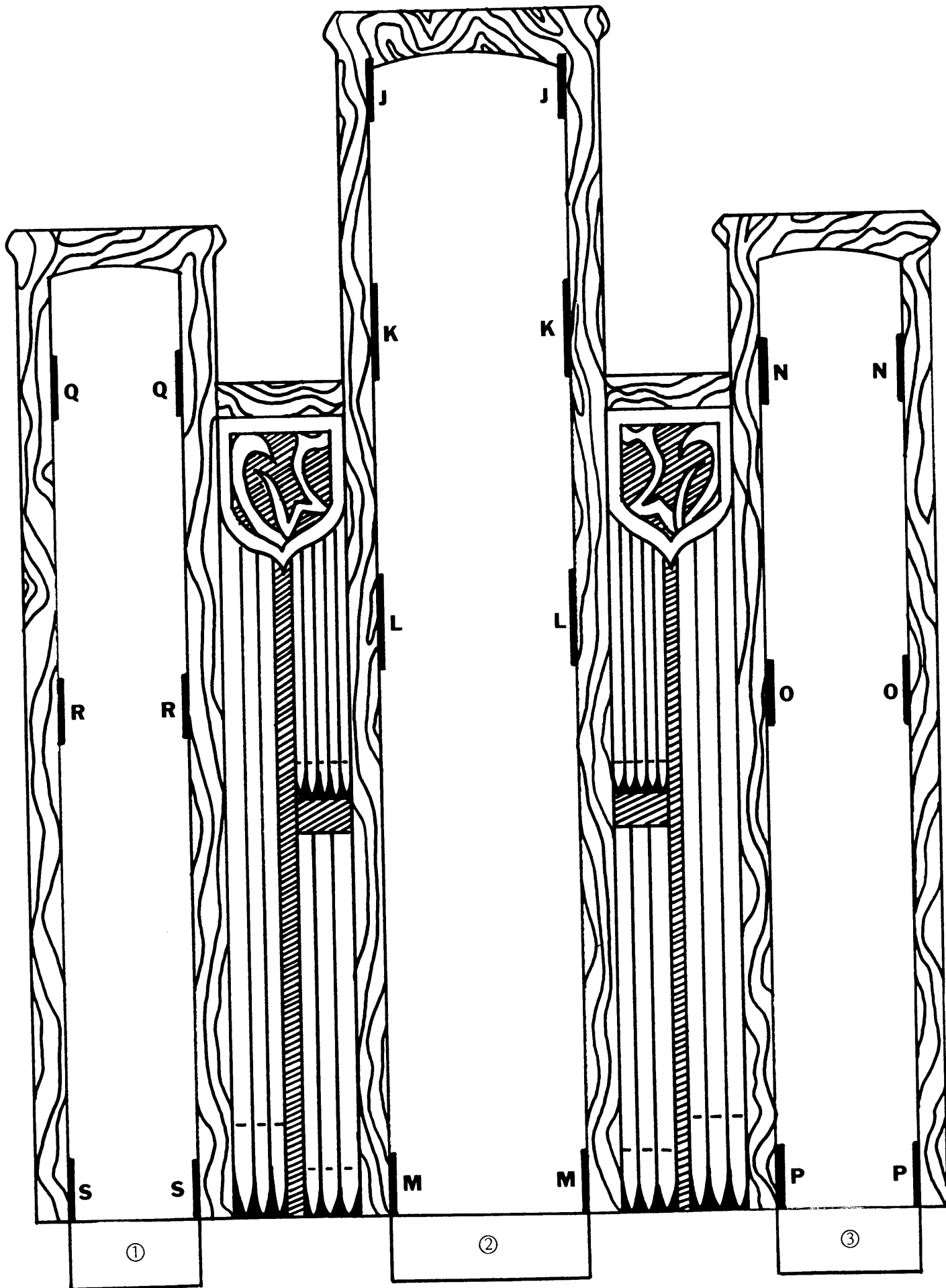


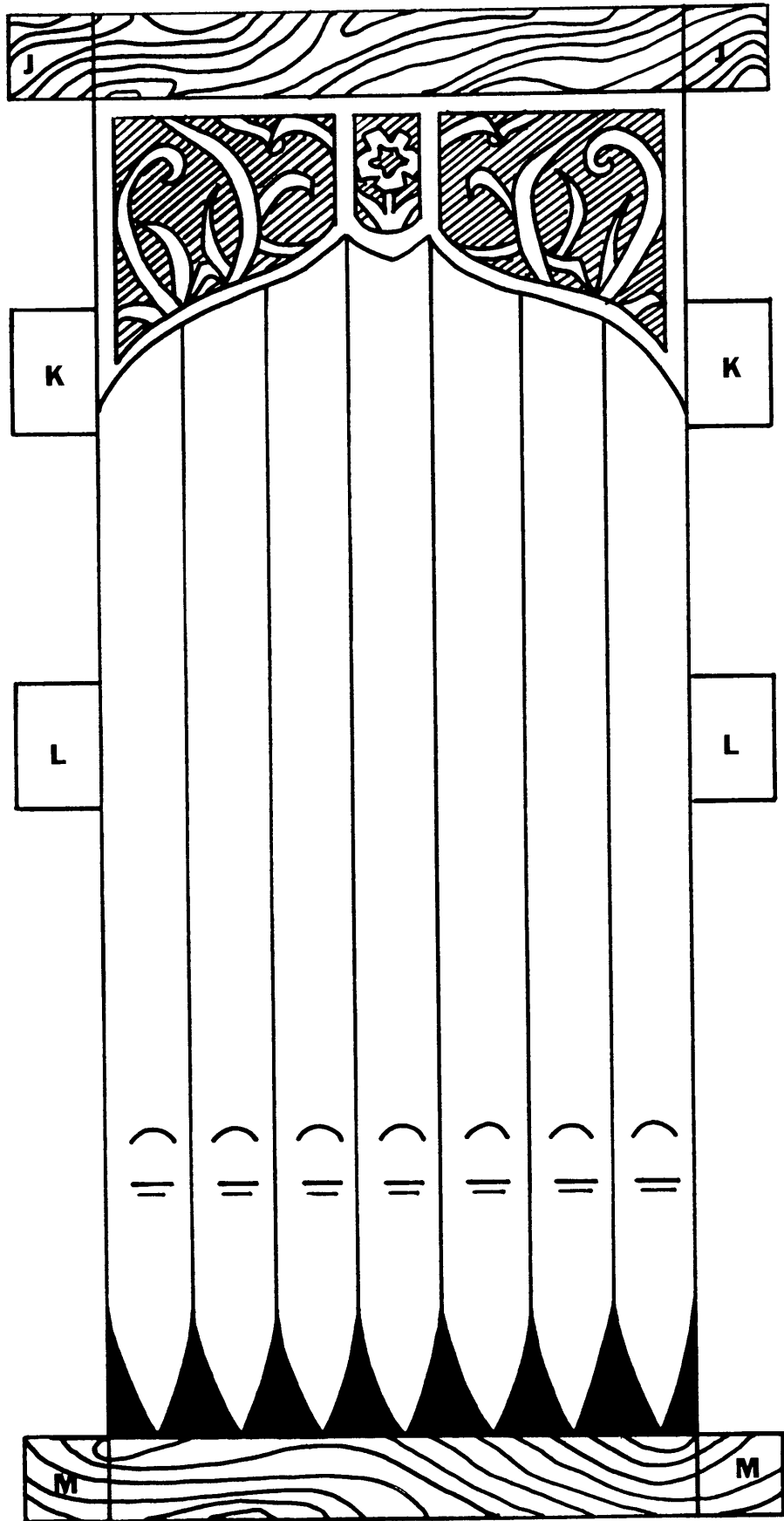
CASING: top

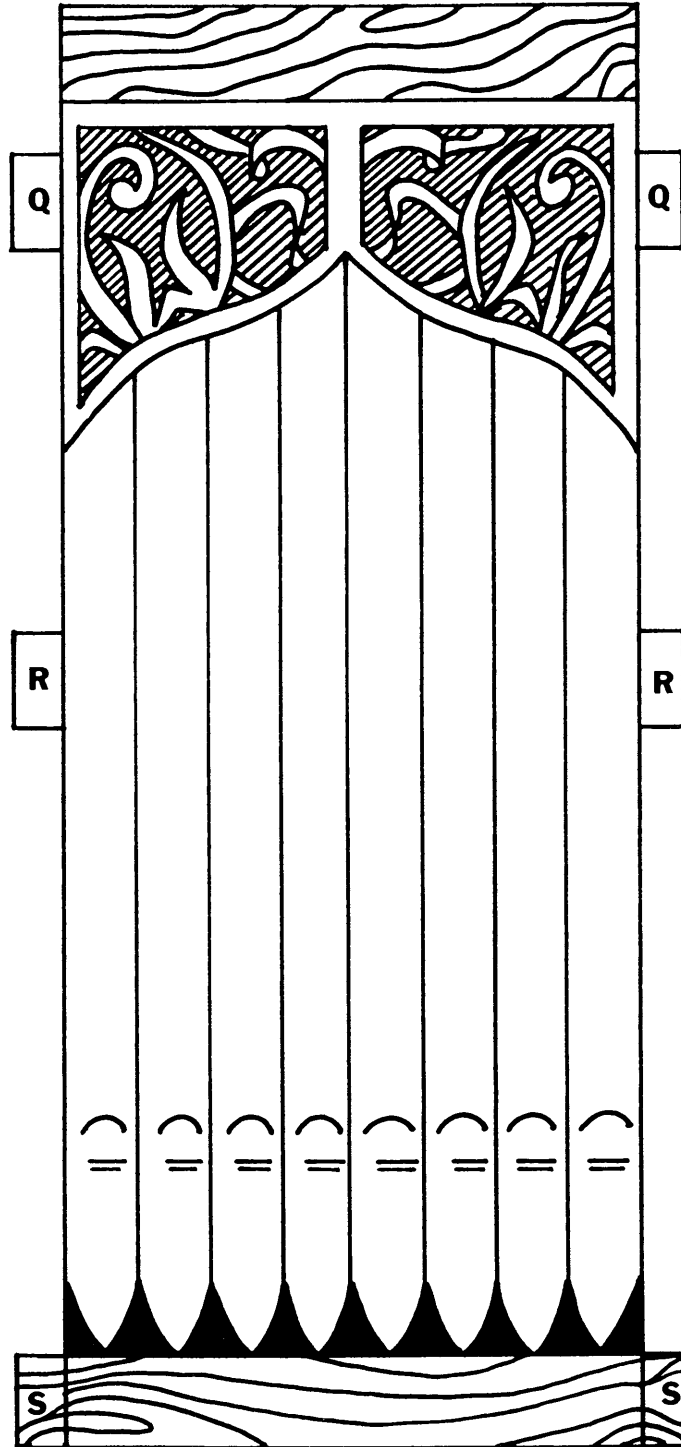
Casing side

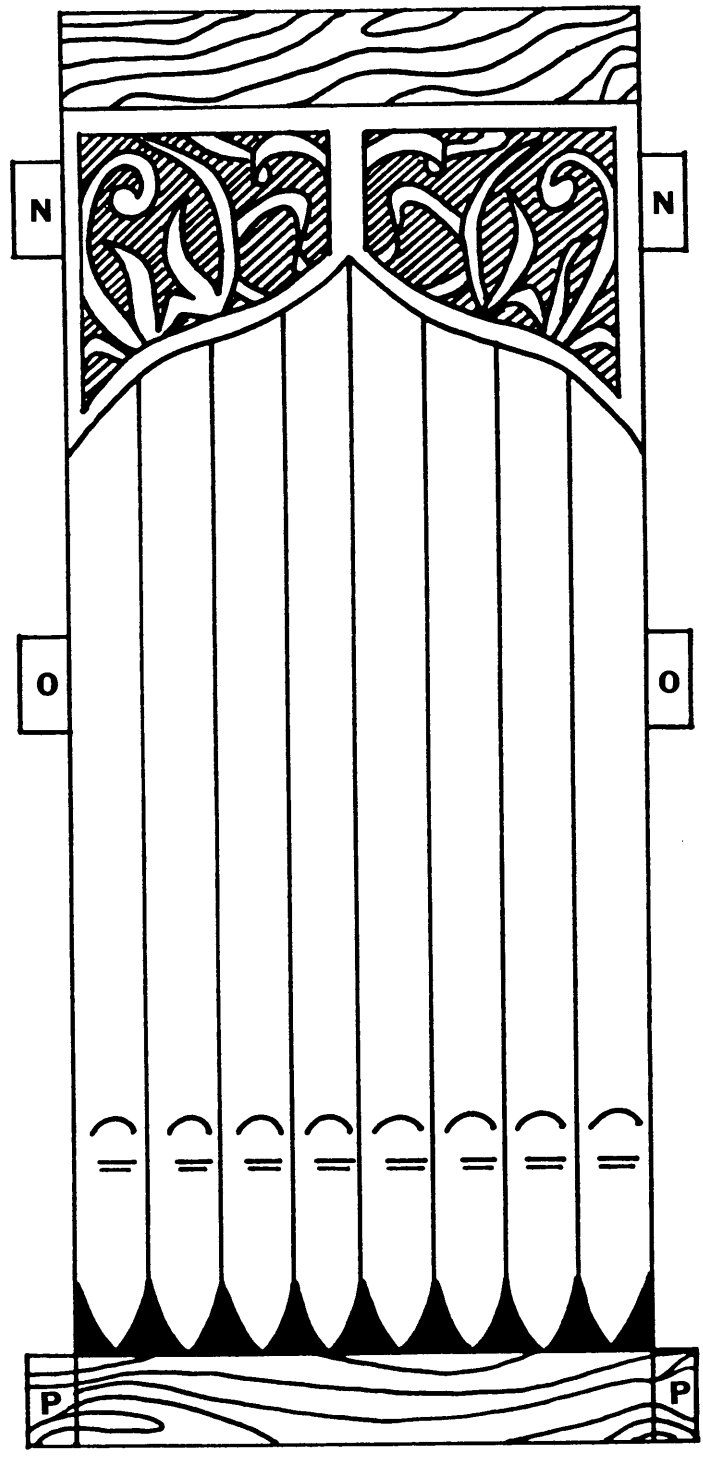
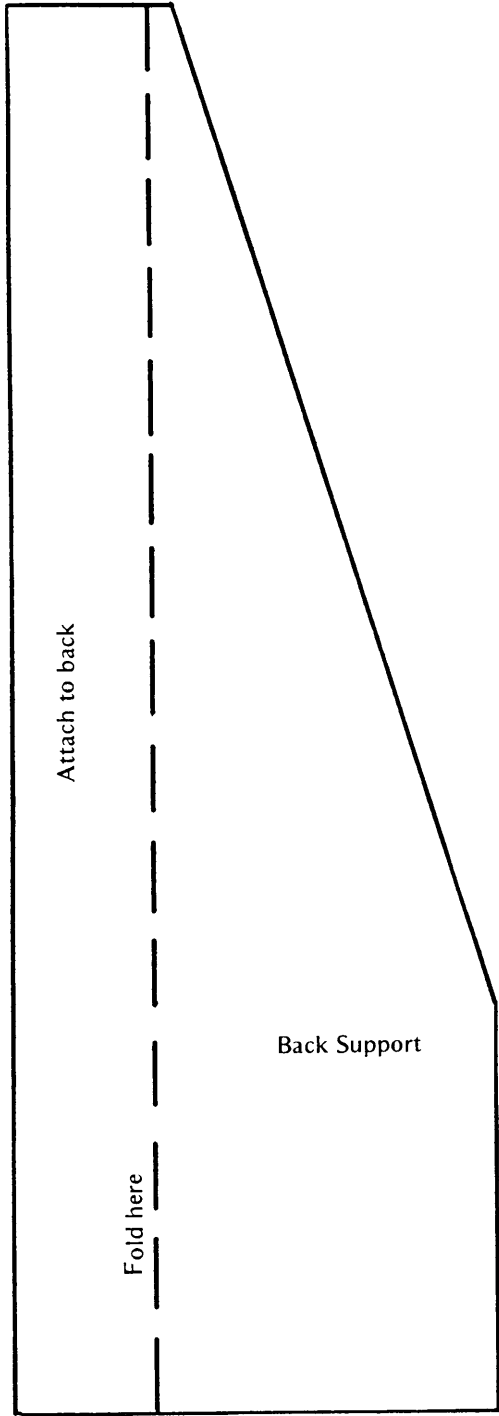


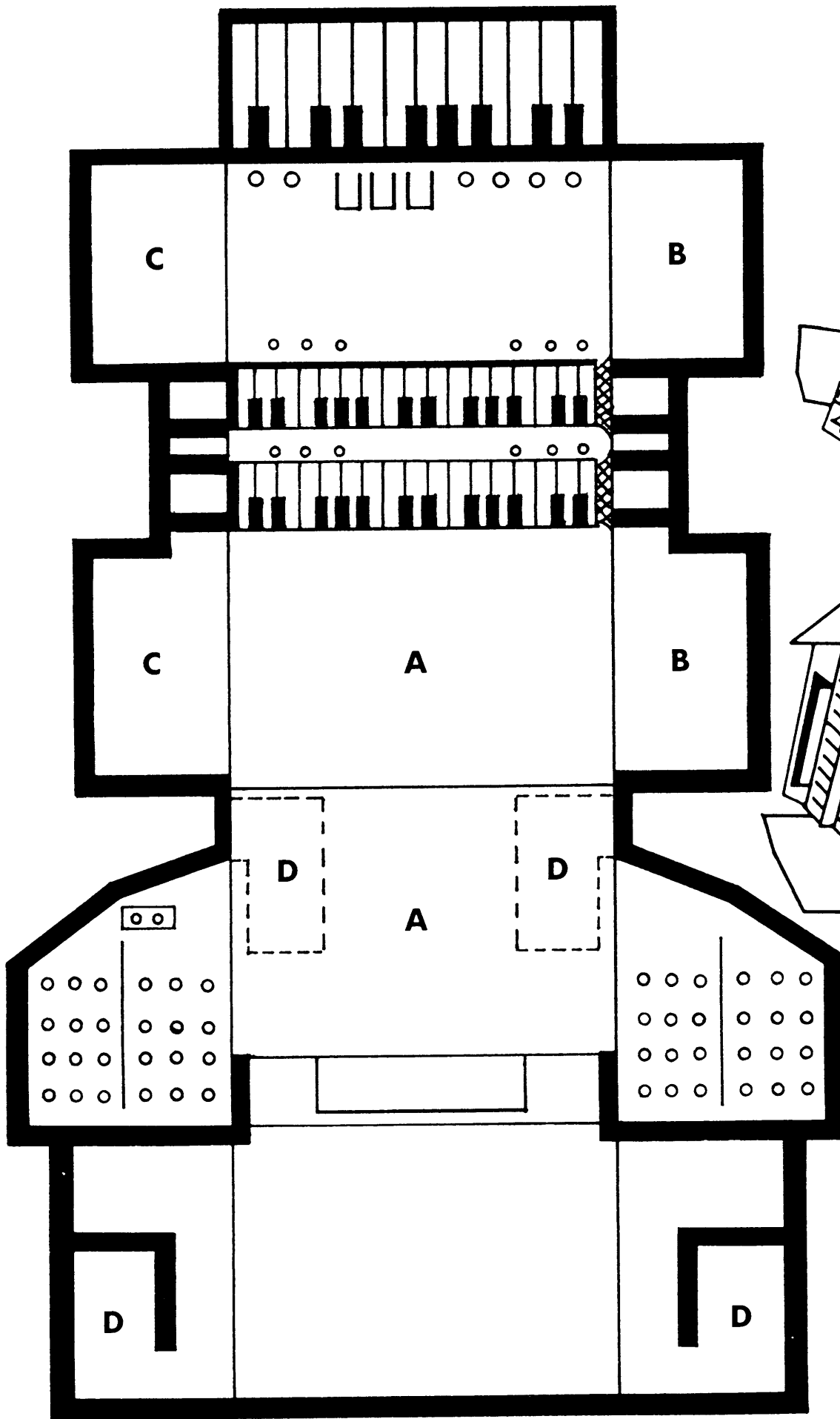
