## **Psalm Detective**

Carefully read the following three Bible passages.
"Shout for joy to God our defender; sing praise to the God of Jacob! Start the music and beat the tambourines; play pleasant music on the harps and lyres. Blow the trumpet for the festival, when the moon is new and when the moon is full." (Psalm 81: 1 - 3)
